- Applicants must have a grade point average of 3.0 or above.
- Applicants must have been a member of TSA.
- Applicants must have applied to and be accepted by or already in attendance at a college or university in Georgia.
- Recipient must major in Engineering.
- The GA TSA office handles funds in the following manner: \$250.00 will be payable to the registrar of the post -secondary institution upon receipt of an official acceptance letter and prior to September 1. The remaining \$250.00 will be sent upon receipt of documentation of a first semester/quarter cumulative grade average of 3.0 or above.
- Changes in schools, majors, and entry dates may result in the loss of scholarship funds if not submitted and approved by the Georgia TSA state office.
- The scholarship application will not be accepted without all requested documents.
